Test Regulations:	The Lönssuche will be conducted in accordance with the current test regulations of the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer e.V. The basis for these regulations is the VZPO of the JGHV, together with the latest additions to the Lönssuche Test Regulations.

International Breed Show:	Participation in the Breed Show is mandatory for all dogs that participate in the Lönssuche. Dogs with faults that disqualify them from breeding are excluded from the overall evaluation but may participate in the HZP. The title “Lönssieger” requires passing all parts of the test, including the Breed Show. Prior participation in a Breed Show or preliminary inspection is therefore recommended.
Entries:	The 2026 Lönssuche is limited to 42 dogs. Until the registration deadline, two spots are available for each Landesgruppe or member country of KIM-I. The Test Director will decide on the allocation of any remaining spots after the registration deadline. Registration must be done exclusively through the respective Landesgruppe. Foreign handlers whose dogs belong to the KIM-I must register directly with the Test Director.

Admission Requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Entry in the stud book of the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer or in a stud book recognized by KIM-I • Whelped after September 30, 2024 • Successful completion of the VJP and HZP with a minimum score of "good" (6 points) in all natural ability subjects • A copy of the HZP test certificate must be presented to the Test Director no later than the registration for the Lönssuche on October 7, 2026 • No physical or behavioral faults that would exclude the dog from breeding • Presentation of a valid EU pet passport (PET Passport) with documented rabies vaccination • Valid hunting license or equivalent license in the country of origin • Own shotgun with lead-free ammunition for field and water work • Foreign handlers will be provided with a firearm if necessary. • For handlers who do not have a German hunting license, shooting will be performed by an authorized person.
Game:	Handlers must bring their own drag game. The live duck for the water work will be provided exclusively by the organizer.
Association Judges:	Each Landesgruppe must send Association Judges at its own expense, based on the number of registered dogs (1–2 dogs = 1 Association Judge; 3–4 dogs = 2 Association Judges, etc.), or it must cover the costs of the Association Judges appointed by the organizer.
Meals:	Meals will be provided for handlers and Judges during the test.
Other:	The evening before, all handlers will receive a program detailing group assignments, the schedule, and meeting points. The testing language is German. Upon passing, the dogs will receive: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an HZP score sheet • a Breed Show certificate
